Its mission is to contribute to strengthening capacities to impulse social development, life quality, and equity in Colombia. The vision of FC is to develop innovative, replicable, and sustainable models.

FC is an independent foundation that has been active for the past 60 years. It was established through an endowment from the Echavarría Olozaga Family, and aims to be a leader in building sustainable models that improve the quality of life of Colombians.



FC works to promote social mobility through education to employment pathways and citizen participation. It employs a systemic approach that builds on the capacities of local actors in all its processes.



FC collaborates with organizations through multi-stakeholder alliances, while further making all Foundation data available to the public. Its key "Inclusive Employment Model" and "Model of Citizen Involvement Participa+" are open-access.



FC adopts a welcoming approach to collaboration with citizens and partners. With over 300 national and global partners, FC aims to build knowledge, create tools, influence systems, and deploy solutions through integral interventions in prioritized cities.

FC's Impact

FC has joined efforts with over 300 allies to achieve change. Embodying the ideals of SLOW, FC has achieved the following over the past 10 years:

- Supported the employment of 25,000+ individuals struggling to secure jobs
- Advised 1,000+ enterprises on how to adopt inclusive employment practices
- Supported 1,000+ leaders in developing their participation and advocacy skills
- Aided the engagment of 30,000 citizens in participatory networks.
